April 2019

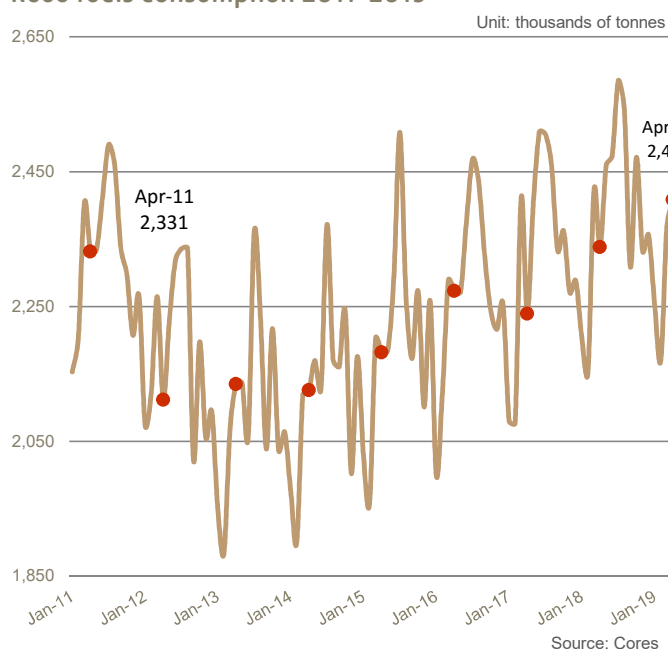
Road fuel consumption in April 2019 (2,408 kt) surpassed the level of April 2011 (2,331 kt)

In April, after the decrease of the previous month, road fuel consumption increased again (+3.0% vs. April 2018), having registered the highest consumption of a month of April since 2010; both gasoline (+9.2%) and gasoil (+1.7%) rose. In the year-to-date, gasoline consumption increased (+6.2%), whilst road diesel decreased slightly (-0.2%).

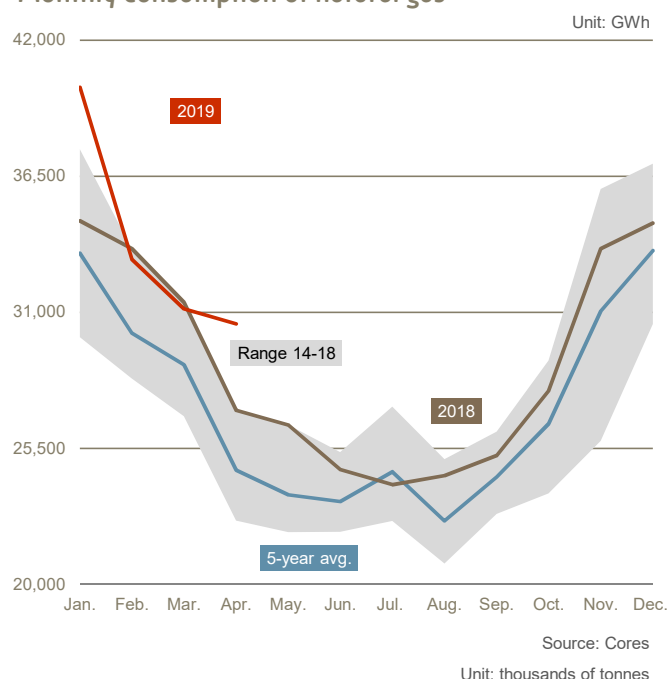
This month, gasolines consumption (+9.2%), kerosene (+4.5%) and gasoil (+0.9%) rose, whilst LPG (-3.8%) and fuel oil (-0.1%) consumption decreased. In the year-to-date, every petroleum product group presented interannual growth, except gasoil (-0.6%): LPG (+0.8%), gasolines (+6.2%), kerosene (+4.7%), and fuel oil (+4.3%).

Natural gas consumption, after the decreases of previous months, rose again in April (+12.9% vs. April 2018), having reached 30,534 GWh. The one intended for electricity generation presented again a significant increase (+104.8%), conventional consumption and direct consumption LNG also rose (+0.6% and +8.1% respectively). In the year-to-date, natural gas consumption rose by 6.5%, due to the increase of every consumption type: conventional (+0.2%), electricity generation (+47.3%) and direct consumption LNG (+12.2%).
