



In April, road fuel consumption decreased (-59.1% vs. April 2019)

## Preliminary Consumption Information


April 2020

In April, the decrease of road fuel consumption intensified (-59,1% vs. April 2019 and -44.4% vs. March 2020), having reached 984 kt, the minimum since available data (January 1996). Gasolines diminished by -77.8% vs. April 2019 and by -64.7% vs. March 2020, whilst road diesel decreased by -55.0% vs. April 2019 and by -40.6% vs. March 2020. In the year-to-date, road fuel consumption decreased by -21.0%, with a greater drop in gasoline (-26.0%) than in road diesel (-19.9%).

This month, the consumption of every petroleum product group decreased: kerosene presented again the highest decrease (-92.9%), followed by gasolines (-77.8%), gasoil (-36.2%), fuel oil (-34.8%) and LPG (-26.0%). In the year-to-date, every petroleum product group presented interannual decreases, LPG (-6.2%), gasolines (-26.0%), kerosene (-36.7%), gasoil (-9.2%) and fuel oil (-34.4%).

This month, there was a significant decrease of natural gas consumption (-22.3% vs. April 2019), having reached 23,777 GWh. The consumption of every type diminished, the one intended for electricity generation (-32.6%) experienced the highest decrease, although it was 32.4% higher than in April 2018, followed by conventional consumption (-20.0%), the lowest consumption for a month of April since 2014, and direct consumption LNG (-12.7%). In the year-to-date, natural gas consumption decreased by -7.9%: conventional consumption (-8.0%) and the one intended for electricity generation decreased (-9.3%), whilst direct consumption LNG increased (+3.5%).

## Road fuels consumption 1996-2020




