



# Natural gas imports & exports in Spain by country

#### February 2020


This month, natural gas net imports reached 29,001 GWh (+0.2%), slightly higher than those of February 2019. LNG net imports increased (+55.3%), whilst those through pipeline decreased (-40.7%).

In February, natural gas imports presented a slightly increase (+0.2%) vs. February 2019 and reached 29,345 GWh. 65.8% of the total was imported as LNG and the remaining 42.4% through pipeline. By geographical areas, natural gas imports from North America (+3,621.2%) and Central and South America (+50.4%) rose interannually, whilst natural gas supplies from the Middle East (-19.5%), Europe and Eurasia (-32.7%) and Africa (-36.3%) decreased. United States (7,924 GWh, 27.0% of the total) was the main natural gas supplier to Spain for the first time since available data and presented a remarkable increase vs. February 2019 (213 GWh; +3,621.2%). It was followed by Algeria (22.6% of the total), despite decreasing by 38.4% interannually.

Natural gas exports rose and reached 344 GWh (+3.4% vs. February 2019). LNG (+107.9%) increased interannually, whilst those through pipeline decreased (-34.7%). In February, Portugal remained as the main export destination (35.1% of the total), despite decreasing by 50.6% vs. February 2019, followed by France (23.4% of the total) and Gibraltar (20.2%).


### United States, the main natural gas supplier to Spain in February 2020 (7,924 GWh)

#### Import distribution by geographical areas January-February 2020\*\*


