Natural gas imports & exports in Spain by country

March 2015

Spain's natural gas net imports, that reach 24,361 GWh in March, continue decreasing (-8.6%) without interruption since November 2014. Natural gas net imports brought in by gas pipeline drop (-37.3% vs. March 2014) in contrast with the increase registered by LNG net imports (+47.8%).


Natural gas imports decrease for the fifth consecutive month (-22.6% compared to March 2014), and accumulate a decrease of 17.6% in the first quarter of of the year. This month, natural gas imported by pipeline registers a new minimum (26,115 GWh) since August 2004 (23,359 GWh). Only natural gas imports from Qatar and Nigeria register interannual increases (+28.6% and 15.0%, respectively).

In the first quarter of the year, Spain's main gas suppliers are Algeria (52.7%), Norway (11.6%), Qatar (11.4%) and Nigeria (9.3%).

Natural gas exports (1,753.8 GWh) decrease in March 75.2% year-on-year due to the strong drop registered in LNG exports (-97.7%). This month, exports were only made to Portugal, France, Italy and Switzerland.


In the rolling year, LNG exports represent 82.4% of the total, in contrast with natural gas exported by pipeline (the remaining 17.6%).

Import weight by type of supply




Import distribution January - March 2015**
