

Crude oil imports to Spain historical maximum [6,558 kt]

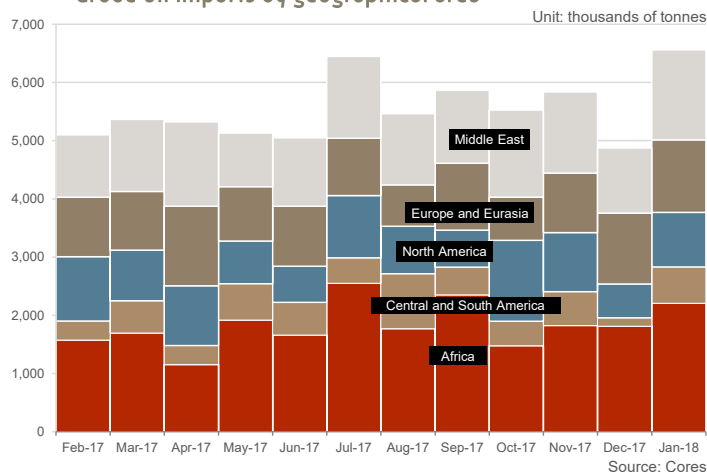
Crude oil imports to Spain rose (+11.6% vs. January 2017) up to 6,558 kt, historical greatest value since available information.

This month 34 types of crude oil were imported from 18 countries. Main provider in the month was Libya (15.9% of the total), for the first time since September of 2010, having registered its entries historical maximum (1,044 kt) and having incremented by 326.1% vs. Jan-17. Besides, crude oil imports ascents were outstanding from Kazakhstan (+257.8% vs. Jan-17) and Brazil (+145.3%).

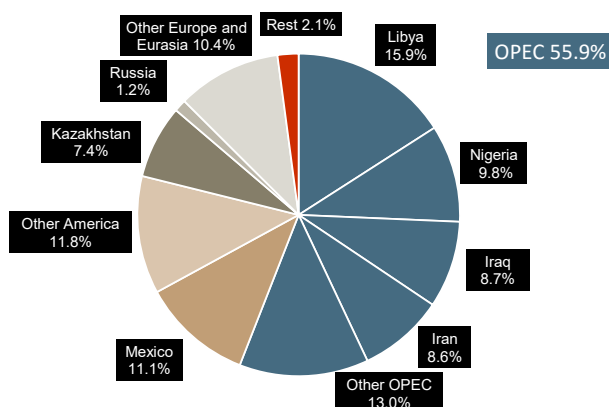
OPEC country members imports rose 38.5% in the month and reached the highest imports registered (3,669 kt). Imports increases outstood from Iraq and Iran, which grew 137.3% and 99.6% respectively.

Crude oil imports ascended from Middle East (+44.1% vs. Jan-17), Africa (+28.5%) and Europe and Eurasia (+2.0%), whilst diminished from North America (-14.8%) and Central and South America (-18.6%). Africa concentrated 33.7% of the total, placed as main supplying area, followed by Middle East (23.5%) and Europe and Eurasia (19.0%).
