

Crude oil imports reached 5,896 kt (-9.4% vs. January 2018)

January 2019


Crude oil imports to Spain in January were 5,896 kt and decreased by 9.4% interannually, due to the historical maximum of entries reached in January 2018.

This month 28 types of crude oil were imported from 16 countries.


Mexico (812 kt) was again the main crude oil supplier after 6 months and rose by 11.4% vs. January 2018. It was followed by Saudi Arabia (801 kt), with a 96.3% increase, and Kazakhstan (725 kt), with the greatest imports registered since available data (1996). Crude oil imports stood out from Azerbaijan (367 kt), the highest since October 2014, and from Venezuela (358 kt), the greatest since November 2015.

Crude oil imports from the OPEC country members diminished 16.4% vs. January 2018, having been the first decrease in 6 months. Despite the slight increase presented (3.3%), entries from Nigeria (661 kt) were the smallest in 7 months.

By geographical area, entries increased from Central and South America (+21.8% vs. January 2018), North America (+11.1%) and Europe and Eurasia (+0.2%) and decreased from Middle East (-10.8%) and Africa (-31.1%), that remained as the main supplying area (25.8%), although with the smallest share since April 2017.
