

Spanish crude oil imports by country

July 2015

July crude oil imports reach their maximum (5,978 kt) since March 1999 (6,031 kt)

In July, crude oil imports to Spain increase 25.6%, reaching 5,978 kt, second highest value recorded since available data (1996). Imports from all geographic areas grow: Europe and Eurasia (+68.8%), Central and South America (+52.7%), Africa (+12.9%), Middle East (+9.1%) and North America (+6.8%). Crude oil imports from Non-OPEC countries increase (+45.3%) and represent a 56.1% share of total imports in July.

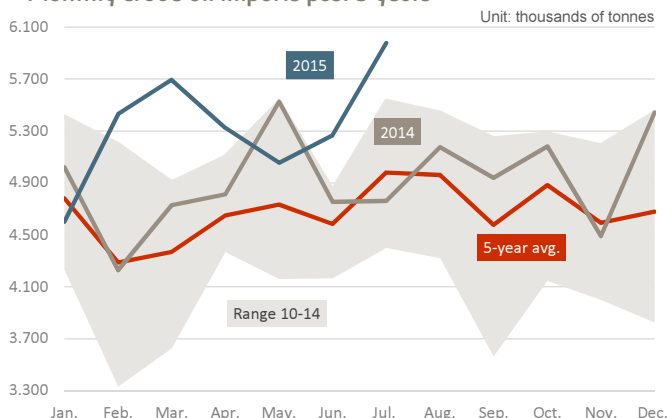
This month, 32 types of crude oil were imported from 19 different countries.

In the year-to-date, main suppliers are Nigeria (15.6%), Mexico (13.8%) and Saudi Arabia (11.0%).

In 2015, crude oil imports rise 10.4% compared with the same period of 2014. Increases in imports from Brazil (+186.9%), Equatorial Guinea (+101.7%) and Iraq (+60.6%) are remarkable. Also, imports from Europe and Eurasia remain stable (-0.5%), in spite of Russia's cumulative descent (-26.2%), due mainly to increases in imports from United Kingdom (+46.4%), Azerbaijan (+77.9%) and Norway (+230.8%).

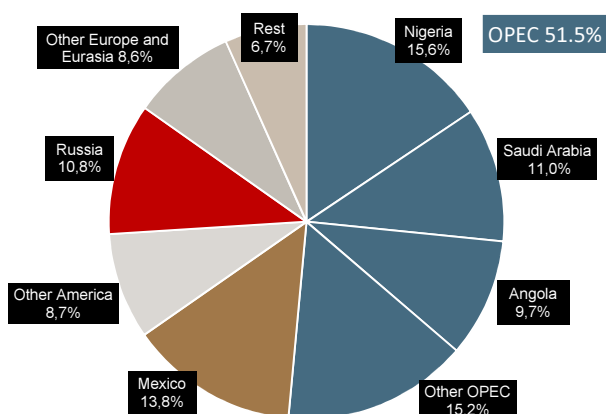
In the rolling year, Africa remains main area of crude oil supply (37.9%). Europe and Eurasia's imports make for 18.1% of the share, despite being the only area to register a drop in the last twelve months (-3.8%). Middle East (15.3%), North America (14.4%) and Central and South America (14.1%) follow.
