

# Spanish crude oil imports by country

November 2017

Highest crude oil imports from Libya (741 kt) were reached since April of 2010

Crude oil imports to Spain registered 5,836 kt, 1.6% less than in the same month of 2016. In the year-to-date and the rolling year they raised 3.7% and 3.3% respectively.

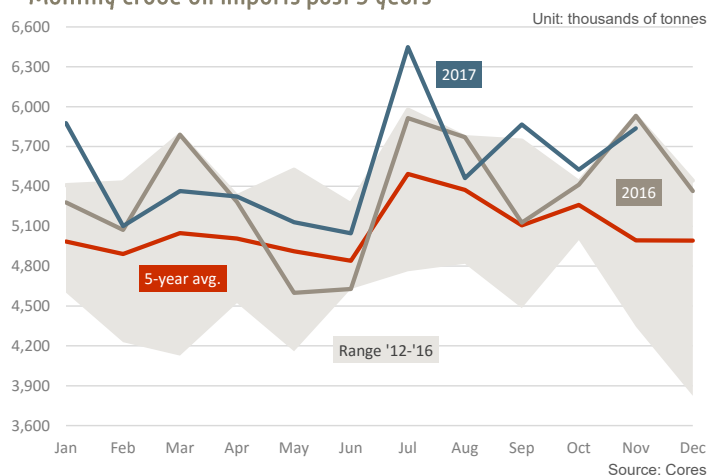
In November 33 types of crude oil were imported from 18 countries.

Mexico remained as the main supplier in the month (768 kt); followed by Libya (741 kt) with the highest imports since April of 2010 (+104.6% interannual). Imports outstood from Russia (379 kt), the greatest in 12 months; Brazil (555 kt) and Azerbaijan (231 kt), the second highest in the year for both. Crude oil purchases from Iran grew in the year-to-date and the rolling year 70.7% and 82.9% respectively, as well as the ones from Norway, 165.2% and 176.4%.

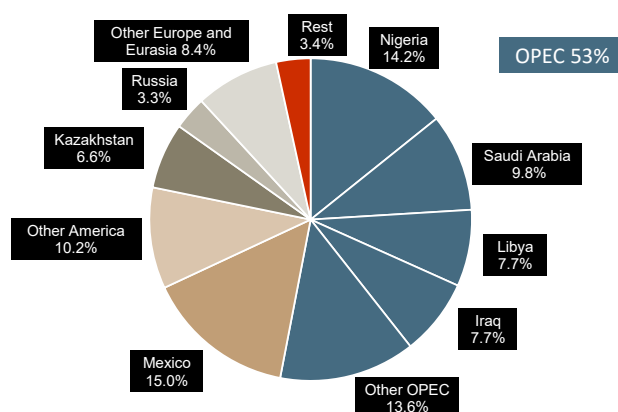
In November, crudes proceeding from the OPEC country members (3,176 kt) reached 54.4% of the total, despite the decreases experienced (-3.6% vs. November of 2016) for the first time in 6 months, partially caused by the lessening of Nigeria and Iraq.

Imports from Africa predominated in the month (31.2% of the total), although they diminished 8.9% vs. November of the previous year; it is followed by imports from Middle East (23.9%), with decreases in every origin country, and Europe & Eurasia (17.5%), which grew 29.1%. This hierarchy in the supplying areas remained as well for the year-to-date and the rolling year.
