

Spanish crude oil imports by country

October 2018

Crude oil imports to Spain reached 6,059 kt (+9.6% vs. October 2017)

Crude oil imports to Spain rose for the third consecutive month (+9.6% vs. October 2017) to reach 6,059 kt. They also presented increases in the remaining periods of analysis, 2.5% in the year to date and 1.3% in the rolling year.

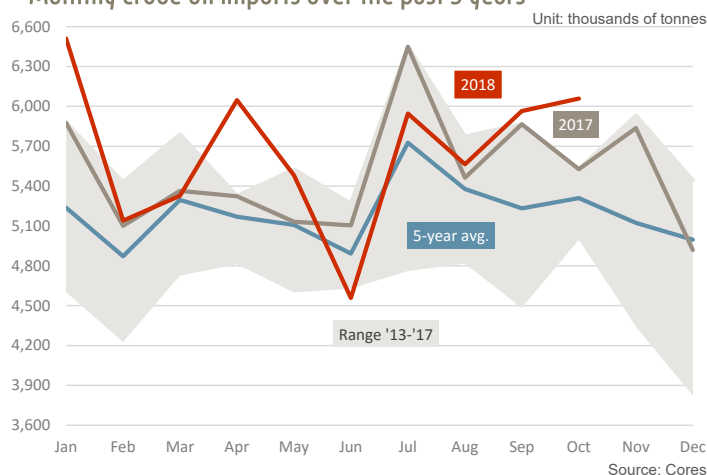
This month 34 types of crude oil were imported from 19 countries.

Nigeria remained as the main crude oil supplier (1,041 kt), with the greatest imports since February 2016. It is followed by Mexico (596 kt), which decreased by 50.0% interannually, and Libya (573 kt), which rose by 15.3%. Major crude oil providers in the year to date are Nigeria, Mexico and Saudi Arabia.

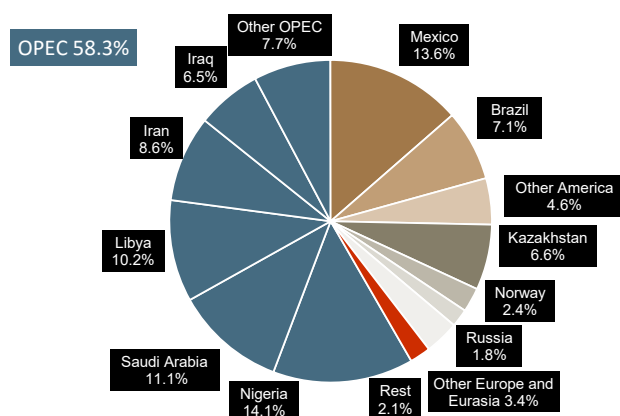
In October imports proceeding from the OPEC members reached 60.5% of the total and increased by 27.4% interannually, because of the imports from Irak (+82.1%) and Venezuela (+63.0%), and despite the diminishing in the entries from Iran (-34.6%) and Saudi Arabia (-28.4%) among others.

Africa (35.5% of the total) continued as the main providing area and rose by 45.7% interannually. Crude oil imports decreased from Middle East (-8.7%) and North America (-43.0%), and increased both from Central and South America (+90.8%), having stood out Brazil (507 kt; +53.0% vs. October 2017), and from Europe and Eurasia (+27.4%), having stood out Kazakhstan (539 kt; +31.1%) and Norway (319 kt; +136.3%).
