Crude oil imports to Spain stood at 5,682 kt, which means an interannual decrease of 6.2%. Imports also diminished in the year to date (-1.3%) and rolling year (-0.8%).


This month 32 types of crude oil were imported from 17 countries.

Nigeria is the first crude oil supplier for the third consecutive month, having risen by 20.2% vs. October 2018 and having reached 1,251 kt. It was followed by Mexico (731 kt) and Libya (658 kt), with remarkable increases in their crude oil deliveries, +22.7% and +14.8% respectively. This month stood out the amount of crude oil entries from Norway (415 kt), the highest since October 2014, and from the United States (350 kt), the historical record


Imports from the OPEC country members presented a 5.4% decreases vs. October 2018, although they increased in the year to date (+3.4%) and the rolling year (+5.6%). Crude oil descent from Iraq stood out (-46.4%), only 284 kt.

Africa (43.2%) remained as the main providing area, having increased its entries by 14.2% interannual, it was followed by North America (19.0%), which rose by 36.5%. The rest of the areas registered decreases in their imports: Europe and Eurasia (-1.4%), Middle East (-38.4%) and Central and South America (-53.8%).
