



## Preliminary Consumption Information October 2017

Road fuel chained six consecutive months of increase (+5.3% vs. October 2016)


In October road fuel consumption increased (+5.3% vs. October 2016) chaining six consecutive months growth, both road diesel (+5.2%) and gasolines (+5.6%) rose. In the year to date, both fuel consumption also increase: 2.6% road diesel and, to a lesser extent, gasolines (+2.3%).

This month gasoline (+5.6%), gasoil (+4.3%) and kerosene (+9.6%) consumption grew, whilst LPG and fuel oil diminished 38.1% and 4.3% respectively. In the year to date LPG (-4.2%) and fuel oil (-4.1%) consumption showed decreases whilst gasolines (+2.3%), kerosene (+9.1%) and gasoil (+1.5%) consumption increased.


Again, in October as per every month in 2017, except April, natural gas consumption increased (+5.5% vs. October 2016), having reached 28,574 GWh. This month intended for electricity generation (+19.2%) grew, as well as direct consumption of LNG (+23.8%), whilst conventional consumption decreased slightly (-0.4%).

In the year to date, natural gas consumption grew (+9.2%), due to the increments of every natural gas type of supply: conventional (+4.3%), electricity generation (+31.7%) and direct consumption LNG (+6.5%)
